EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

The Village of New Denver is currently accepting applications for the following permanent full-time position: **UTILITY 3 ROLE:**

This senior employee in the Village of New Denver's public works department will report to the Village's CAO and will be responsible for the operation of municipal infrastructure.

The position is a working position, suitable for individuals with experience across a wide range of municipal operations including water systems, snow removal, garbage collection, roads, parks, cemeteries and fleet maintenance.

The successful candidate will be required to plan projects, exercise judgement and show initiative. The ability to supervise and train others is expected.

This is a unionized position, and preference will be given to qualified members in good standing of the International Union of Operating Engineers. Consideration will be given to applicants that do not currently have EOCP Level 2 Water Operator certification but are eligible to write the exam.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

- All duties and responsibilities of Utility 2;
- Operation of equipment, with attachments, such as trucks, loaders, backhoes, snowplows, sander, crawler tractors, garbage trucks, etc.;
- Maintaining, operating and repairing of roads, lanes and sidewalks, water and sewer systems, fire hydrants, garbage disposal areas, etc.;
- May be required to train personnel in lower classifications in operation and care of equipment;
- Other related duties as may be assigned from time to time;
- Maintain and repair equipment as required;
- Prepare annual budget for public works department;
- Organization of public works and utility projects;
- Manage public works staff to ensure completion of necessary projects;
- Ensure public works staff compliance with certification and safety requirements.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Valid B.C. Driver's License, minimum Class 3, with air brakes endorsement;
- Experienced working knowledge of water system operation, and road and street maintenance;
- EOCP Level 2 Water Operator Certification;
- Physically fit.
